PRESS RELEASE - July 16, 2025

ARRESTS

1. **Misdemeanors - (1) Domestic Simple Assault, and (2) Domestic Disorderly Conduct:** On Thursday June 19, 2025, at approximately 8:47 P.M., Patrolman Ryan Donohue and Patrolman Derek Adams arrested **Cheyenne Keener**, age 32, of 323 Church Street, Richmond, on charges of (1) *Domestic Simple Assault*, (2) *Domestic Disorderly Conduct*. The arrest occurred after officers responded to a reported disturbance that had taken place at a residence. Ms. Keener was taken into custody and transported to the station where she was processed and arraigned by a Bail Commissioner. Ms. Keener was released on a promise to appear in the 4th Division District Court at a later date for re-arraignment on the charges.
2. **Misdemeanor - Criminal Violation of a No-Contact Order:** On Thursday June 26, 2025, at approximately 2:25 P.M., **Cheyenne Keener**, age 32, of 323 Church Street, Richmond, turned herself in at the Richmond Police Station to answer to an outstanding affidavit and arrest warrant for *Violation of a Domestic No-Contact Order*. The arrest occurred after Patrolman Michael Ellis investigated a complaint regarding the violation of the court order. Ms. Keener was taken into custody where she was processed and arraigned by a Bail Commissioner. Ms. Keener was transported to the Adult Correctional Institutions Women's Facility where she was held pending an appearance in the 4th Division District Court.
3. **Wayward Juvenile - Possession of Alcohol by an Underage Person:** On Thursday June 26, 2025, a 17-year-old juvenile from Richmond was petitioned to the RI Family Court to answer to a charge of *Possession of Alcohol by an Underage Person*. The referral occurred after Patrolman Adam Andrukiewicz and Patrolman Dan Ballou assisted Hope Valley Ambulance with a juvenile at a residence experiencing ill effects of alcohol consumption.
4. **Misdemeanors - (1) Simple Assault, and (2) Disorderly Conduct:** On Saturday, June 28, 2025, at approximately 8:32 P.M., Sergeant William Litterio and Patrolman Ryan Donohue arrested **Angelo R. Mercurio**, age 54, of 19 Aldrich Street, Hopkinton, on charges of (1) *Simple Assault*, and (2) *Disorderly Conduct*. The arrest occurred after a

complainant entered the station and reported that he had been assaulted by Mr. Mercurio after an interaction on Main Street. Mr. Mercurio was processed and released on a summons to appear in 4th Division District Court to be arraigned on the charges.

5. **Misdemeanor- Operating on a Suspended License (4th or Subsequent Offense):**

On Monday, June 30, 2025, at approximately 5:06 PM, Patrolman Adam Andrukiewicz arrested **Raven M. Machado**, age 26 of 289 Bradford Road, Bradford, for *Operating on a Suspended License (4th Offense)*. Mr. Machado was stopped on Shannock Hill Road for a motor vehicle violation. Mr. Machado was transported to the Richmond Police Station where he was processed and held overnight as a probation violator. Mr. Machado was transported to 4th Division District Court the following morning to answer to the charge.
