PRESS RELEASE - August 07, 2025

ARRESTS

1. **Misdemeanor- Operating on a Suspended License (4th or Subsequent Offense):** On Thursday, July 17, 2025, at approximately 12:12 PM, Patrolman Michael Ellis summonsed **Ranfi Castillo**, age 35 of 29 Small Pond Road, Richmond to 4th Division District Court for *Operating on a Suspended License (4th Offense)*. Mr. Castillo was stopped on Carolina Noosneck Road for a motor vehicle violation.
2. **Misdemeanor - Disorderly Conduct:** On Saturday, July 19, 2025, Sergeant William Litterio arrested **Bradley Baseler**, age 69, of 3867 South County Trail, Apt. B, Richmond on a charge of *Disorderly Conduct*. Sgt. Litterio had responded to a complaint of Mr. Baseler causing a disturbance with a neighbor. Mr. Baseler was transported to the Richmond Police Station where he was processed and released on a summons to appear in 4th Division District Court to be arraigned on the charge.
3. **Local Warrant:** On Friday, August 01, 2025, at approximately 2:30 PM, Patrolman Derek Adams arrested **Amanda Mulrath**, age 37, of 7 West Shannock Road, Apt. 4A, Richmond, on the strength of an Affidavit and Arrest Warrant by the South Kingstown Police Department for *Obtaining Property Under False Pretenses*. Ms. Mulrath was taken into custody, processed and turned over to the South Kingstown Police Department.
4. **Misdemeanor- (1) Possession of a Schedule II Drug, (Methamphetamine) and (2) Vandalism:** On Monday, August 04, 2025, at approximately 6:07 PM, Sergeant William Litterio and Patrolman Ryan Donohue arrested **Alexander Dent**, age 31, of 32 Madison St., East Hartford, CT, on charges of (1) *Possession of a Schedule II Drug* and (2) *Vandalism*. While on routine patrol, Sgt. Litterio observed a vehicle lodged against the curb at the entrance of a business on Main Street. The vehicle was abandoned, in gear and running. Mr. Dent, the driver of the vehicle, was located in the area. After an investigation on scene, a small glassine bag containing the suspected drug methamphetamine was found in Mr. Dents' vehicle. Mr. Dent was transported to the station where he was processed and arraigned by a Bail Commissioner. Mr. Dent was held overnight pending arraignment the following morning.

While in custody, Mr. Dent caused significant damage to a holding room within the police station. Mr. Dent was transported to the 4th Division District Court where he was arraigned on the charges.
