PRESS RELEASE - August 22, 2025

ARRESTS

1. **Misdemeanor - DUI (1st offense - BAC of .15 or greater):** On Thursday, August 07, 2025, at approximately 11:50 PM, Sergeant Jeff Vaughn and Patrolman Dan Ballou arrested **Natasha D. Pannozzi**, age 34, of 68 Princess Ave., Cranston on a charge of *Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol (1st offense-BAC of .15 or greater)*. A good Samaritan had reported an erratic operator on Nooseneck Hill Road. Ms. Pannozzi was stopped and arrested on suspicion of DUI based on officer observations and her performance on a series of standardized field sobriety tests. Ms. Pannozzi was transported to the station where she submitted to a Breathalyzer Test that resulted in blood-alcohol-content readings of **.185 (1st phase)** and **.184 (2nd phase)**. Ms. Pannozzi was processed and held overnight pending arraignment the following morning in 4th Division District Court.
2. **Misdemeanor - Reckless Driving:** On Thursday, August 14, 2025, at approximately 9:33 PM, Sergeant William Litterio and Patrolman Dan Ballou arrested **Tristan Ansay** age 29, of 79 Leitau Dr., Oakdale, CT, on a charge of *Reckless Driving*. The arrest occurred after the motorcycle Mr. Ansay was operating was caught on RADAR traveling 90 miles-per-hour (MPH) in a posted 35 mph zone on Kingstown Road. Mr. Ansay was alleged to have failed to stop for the University of RI Police Department. Mr. Ansay was returned to the station where he was processed, arraigned by a Bail Commissioner and released on a promise to appear in 4th Division District Court to answer the above charge.
3. **Wayward Juvenile - Reckless Driving:** On Thursday August 14, 2025, a 17-year-old juvenile from Foster was petitioned to the RI Family Court to answer to a charge of *Reckless Driving*. The referral occurred after staff working the Washington County Fair reported the vehicle operating erratically in the parking lot. The juvenile was cited for multiple motor vehicle violations including operating with a suspended license.

4. **Misdemeanors - (1) Criminal Violation of An Order For Protection, (2) Simple Assault, (3) Disorderly Conduct:** On Friday August 15, 2025, at approximately 7:25 P.M., Patrolman Brock Taylor and Patrolman Paul Marshall arrested **Brady Kenyon**, age 23, of 111 Arcadia Rd. Apt. #3, Hopkinton on charges of (1) *Violation of an Order for Protection*, (2) *Simple Assault*, and (3) *Disorderly Conduct*. The arrest occurred after officers investigated a complaint by the protected party in the order. The investigation revealed that Mr. Kenyon allegedly approached a group of people at the Washington County Fair which included the protected person and pushed past the protected person and assaulted another individual nearby. Officers located Mr. Kenyon at the Fairgrounds and took him into custody. He was transported to Richmond Police Station where he was processed and arraigned by a Bail Commissioner. Mr. Kenyon was released on a promise to appear in the 4th Division District Court to be arraigned on the charge.
5. **Local Warrant:** On Saturday, August 16, 2025, at approximately 10:15 AM, Patrolman Michael Ellis, Detective Drew Bishop and Patrolman Brock Taylor arrested **Raymond Krajczynski**, age 60, of 1776 Mendon Road, Woonsocket, on the strength of an Affidavit and Arrest Warrant by the Rhode Island State Police for *Violation of Community Supervision*. Mr. Krajcznski had been on the grounds of the Washington County Fair. Mr. Krajcznski was taken into custody, processed and turned over to the RI State Police.
6. **Wayward Juvenile - Disorderly Conduct:** On Saturday, August 16, 2025, a 13-year-old juvenile from South Kingstown was petitioned to the RI Family Court to answer to a charge of *Disorderly Conduct*. The referral occurred after Patrolman Adam Andrukiewicz responded to an active disturbance on the grounds of the Washington County Fair.
7. **Wayward Juvenile - Disorderly Conduct:** On Saturday, August 16, 2025, a 14-year-old female juvenile from Cranston, RI was petitioned to the RI Family Court to answer to a charge of *Disorderly Conduct*. The referral occurred after Patrolman Adam Andrukiewicz and Patrolman Brock Taylor responded to an active disturbance on the grounds of the Washington County Fair.
8. **Wayward Juvenile - Disorderly Conduct:** On Saturday, August 16, 2025, a 17-year-old female juvenile from West Greenwich, RI was petitioned to the RI Family Court to answer to a charge of *Disorderly Conduct*. The referral occurred after Patrolman Derek Adams and Patrolman Adam Andrukiewicz responded to an active disturbance on the grounds of the Washington County Fair.
9. **Misdemeanor - Possession of Alcoholic Beverage by Underage Person:** On August 17, 2025, at approximately 5:36 P.M., Patrolman Derek Adams summonsed **Austin Lillie**, age 18, of 38 Audobon Lane, Hope, RI, to 4th Division District Court for a charge of *Possession of Alcohol by an Underage Person* after he was found to be in possession of alcohol on the grounds of the Washington County Fairgrounds.
10. **Misdemeanor - Possession of Alcoholic Beverage by Underage Person:** On August 17, 2025, at approximately 5:36 P.M., Patrolman Paul Marshall Summonsed **Myles Charron**, age 18, of 19 Paige Drive, Coventry, RI, for a charge of *Possession of Alcohol by an Underage Person* after he was found to be in possession of alcohol on the grounds of the Washington County Fair
