## PRESS RELEASE - October 14, 2025

### ARRESTS

1. **Bench Warrant:** On Thursday, September 04, 2025, at approximately 4:20 P.M., Patrolman Adam Andrukiewicz arrested **Cheyenne Keener**, age 32, of 323 Church Street, Richmond, on the strength of an outstanding District Court Bench Warrant for *Failure to Appear*. Ms. Keener voluntarily turned herself in at the police station. Ms. Keener was taken into custody, processed and transported to the A.C.I. Women's Intake Service Center.
2. **Local Warrant:** On Thursday, September 04, 2025, at approximately 9:00 AM, **Ashley Heys**, age 42, of 268 Pippin Knoll, Bennington, Vermont, turned himself in at the 4<sup>th</sup> Division District Court in Wakefield to be arraigned on (3) counts of *Violation of a Protection Order*. Detective Drew Bishop sought an arrest warrant for Mr. Heys after investigating a complaint made at the station.
3. **Misdemeanor - DUI (1<sup>st</sup> offense - BAC of .15 or greater):** On Friday, September 12, 2025, at approximately 10:09 PM, Patrolman Adam Andrukiewicz arrested **Deborah Kenyon**, age 69, of 18 Hillsdale Road, Richmond on a charge of *Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol (1<sup>st</sup> offense-BAC of .15 or greater)*. Ms. Kenyon was arrested after the officer came upon her in a disabled vehicle while on patrol. Ms. Kenyon was arrested on suspicion of DUI based on officer observations and her performance on a series of standardized field sobriety tests. Ms. Kenyon was transported to the station and later consented to a blood test that resulted in blood-alcohol-content reading of **.212**. Ms. Kenyon was summonsed to 4<sup>th</sup> Division District Court to be arraigned on the charge.
4. **Misdemeanors - (1) Obstructing a Police Officer, (2) Resisting Arrest and (3) Disorderly Conduct:** On Wednesday, September 17, 2025, at approximately 8:01 P.M., Patrolman Ryan Donohue and Patrolman Adam Andrukiewicz arrested **Ryan M. Lazauskas**, age 49, of 15 Tall Pines Drive, Charlestown, on charges of (1) *Obstructing a Police Officer*, (2) *Resisting Arrest* and (3) *Disorderly Conduct*. The arrest occurred after officers were called to a business on Main Street where it was reported that Mr. Lazauskas was alleged to be impaired and was about to drive a motor vehicle. Mr.

Lazauskas was taken into custody after numerous attempts were made to provide or arrange a safe ride home. Mr. Lazauskas was transported to the station where he was processed and released on summons to appear in the 4<sup>th</sup> Division District Court for arraignment on the charges.

5. **Wayward Juvenile - Disorderly Conduct:** On Friday, September 26, 2025, a 17-year-old juvenile from Charlestown was petitioned to the RI Family Court to answer to charges of (1) *Simple Assault* and (2) *Disorderly Conduct*. The referral occurred after School Resource Officer Michael Ellis responded to a disturbance at the Chariho High School.
6. **Delinquent Juvenile - (1) Breaking and Entering and (2) Possession of Alcohol Under 21 (wayward):** On Saturday, October 04, 2025, a 17-year-old male juvenile from Hopkinton was petitioned to the RI Family Court to answer to charges of (1) *Breaking and Entering* and (2) *Possession of Alcohol Under 21*. The referral occurred after Patrolman Adam Andrukiewicz, Patrolman Ryan Donohue and Patrolman Derek Adams responded to an active Breaking and Entering into a storage barn. The arrest was part of an ongoing investigation by Detective Drew Bishop.
7. **Delinquent Juvenile - (1) Breaking and Entering and (2) Possession of Alcohol Under 21 (wayward):** On Saturday, October 04, 2025, a 14-year-old male juvenile from Richmond was petitioned to the RI Family Court to answer to charges of (1) *Breaking and Entering* and (2) *Possession of Alcohol Under 21*. The referral occurred after Patrolman Adam Andrukiewicz, Patrolman Ryan Donohue and Patrolman Derek Adams responded to an active Breaking and Entering into a storage barn. The arrest was part of an ongoing investigation by Detective Drew Bishop.
8. **Wayward Juvenile - (1) Simple Assault and (2) Disorderly Conduct:** On Tuesday, October 07, 2025, a 16-year-old female juvenile from Richmond was petitioned to the RI Family Court to answer to charges of (1) *Simple Assault* and (2) *Disorderly Conduct*. The referral occurred after Sergeant William Litterio, Patrolman Brock Taylor and Patrolman Dan Ballou responded to a disturbance that had taken place on a school bus in the area of Pine Hill Road in Richmond.
9. **Misdemeanors - (1) Domestic Simple Assault, and (2) Domestic Disorderly Conduct:** On Monday October 13, 2025, at approximately 1:00 A.M., Sergeant Jeff Vaughn and Patrolman Paul Marshall arrested **Colin Moore**, age 38, of 8 Wolf CT, Richmond, on charges of (1) *Domestic Simple Assault*, (2) *Domestic Disorderly Conduct*. The arrest occurred after officers responded to a reported disturbance that had taken place at a residence. Mr. Moore was taken into custody and transported to the station where he was processed and arraigned by a Bail Commissioner. Mr. Moore was released on a promise to appear in the 4<sup>th</sup> Division District Court at a later date for re-arraignment on the charges.
10. **Bench Warrant:** On Monday, October 13, 2025, at approximately 6:30 P.M, Sergeant William Litterio and Patrolman Andy Briody arrested **Charles Debeaulieu**, age 37, of 54 Hoxsie Road, Richmond, on the strength of an outstanding District Court Bench Warrant for *Failure to Appear for Arraignment*. Mr. Debeaulieu was taken into custody and transported to the station where he was processed and arraigned by a Bail Commissioner. Mr. Debeaulieu was given a notice to appear in the 4<sup>th</sup> Division District Court.
