## PRESS RELEASE – February 04, 2026

### ARRESTS

1. **Misdemeanor- DUI (1<sup>st</sup> offense - BAC of .10 - .15) and:** On Sunday, January 18, 2026, at approximately 6:30 PM, Patrolman Ryan Donohue arrested **Charles Harris**, age 56, of 22 Pleasant Street Apt. #3, Westerly on a charge of *Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol (1<sup>st</sup> offense-BAC of .10- .15)*. Mr. Harris was arrested after he was involved in a single-car motor vehicle crash on King Arthur Drive. Mr. Harris was arrested on suspicion of DUI based on officer observations and his performance on a series of standardized field sobriety tests. Mr. Harris was transported to the station where he submitted to a Breathalyzer test that resulted in blood-alcohol-content readings of **.149 (1<sup>st</sup> phase)** and **.148 (2<sup>nd</sup> phase)**. Mr. Harris was processed and released on a summons to appear in the 4<sup>th</sup> Division District Court to be arraigned on the charge.
2. **Misdemeanor - DUI (1<sup>st</sup> offense - BAC unknown) and Refusal To Submit To a Chemical Test (Civil):** On Sunday, January 18, 2026, at approximately 6:00 P.M., Patrolman Paul Marshall arrested **James Gallo, JR.**, age 39, of 71 Cottage Grove Avenue, Warwick, for (1) *Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol (1<sup>st</sup> offense-BAC Unknown)* and (2) *Refusal To Submit To a Chemical Test (civil)*. The arrest occurred after officers responded to a single car motor vehicle crash on Carolina Nooseneck Road. Mr. Gallo was arrested on suspicion of DUI based on officer observations as well as his performance on field sobriety tests. Mr. Gallo was transported to the station where he refused to consent to a chemical test at an officer's request. Mr. Gallo was held overnight as a violator pending his arraignment in 4<sup>th</sup> Division District Court.

3. **Felony- (1) Domestic Simple Assault 3<sup>rd</sup> Offense, and (2) Misdemeanor-Domestic Disorderly Conduct:** On January 31, 2026, at approximately 8:30 P.M., Sergeant William Litterio, Patrolman Ryan Donohue and Patrolman Paul Marshall arrested **Beth Kores**, age 60, of 17 Riverview Drive, Richmond, on charges of (1) *Domestic Assault 3<sup>rd</sup> Offense*, and (2) *Domestic Disorderly Conduct*. The arrest occurred after a call reporting an active disturbance taking place at a residence. Ms. Kores was transported to the station where she was processed and arraigned. She was later taken to the ACI-Women's Intake Service Center where she was held as a violator pending arraignment on the above charges in 4<sup>th</sup> Division District Court.
