PRESS RELEASE - March 19, 2026

ARRESTS

1. **Misdemeanors - (1) Domestic Simple Assault and (2) Domestic Disorderly Conduct:** On Wednesday, March 04, 2026, at approximately 08:33 P.M., Detective Adam Andrukiewicz and Patrolman Ryan Donohue arrested **Kathleen Richardson**, age 61, of 47 Clearview Drive, Richmond, on charges *Domestic Simple Assault* and (2) of *Domestic Disorderly Conduct*. The arrest occurred after officers responded to a 911 hang-up call. Ms. Richardson was taken into custody and transported to the station where she was processed and arraigned by a Bail Commissioner. Ms. Richardson was released on a promise to appear in the 4th Division District Court to be re-arraigned on the charge.
2. **Misdemeanor - Reckless Driving (Eluding a Police Officer):** On Friday, March 13, 2026, at approximately 5:54 PM, Patrolman Derek Adams and Sergeant William Litterio arrested **Samuel Chinigo** age 59, of 111 Roosevelt Ave., Preston, CT, on a charge of *Reckless Driving (Eluding a Police Officer)*. The arrest occurred after the vehicle Mr. Chinigo was observed speeding on Church Street. When the officer turned around to conduct a stop for the violation, Mr. Chinigo accelerated to speeds of approximately 80 MPH and failed to stop for the officer. Mr. Chinigo eventually pulled into a residential driveway and was located by the officer. Mr. Chinigo was returned to the station where he was processed, arraigned by a Bail Commissioner and released on a promise to appear in 4th Division District Court to answer the above charge.
