PRESS RELEASE – April 2, 2013:

1. **Misdemeanor - DUI (BAC > .15):** On March 26, 2013, at approximately 7:00 PM, Corporal William Litterio, assisted by Patrolman Jeffrey Vaughn, arrested **Richard B. Hawkins**, age 44, of 295 Kingstown Road, West Kingstown on a charge of (1) *Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/ or Drugs (1st Offense - BAC greater than .15)*, after a motor vehicle stop on Kingstown Road. Mr. Hawkins submitted to a Breathalyzer test that resulted in BAC (blood-alcohol-content) readings of **.206 (1st phase)** and **.214 (2nd phase)**. Mr. Hawkins was processed and released with a summons to appear for arraignment in 4th District Court on the above charges.
2. **Misdemeanor - DUI (BAC Unknown) & Refusal:** On March 26, 2013, at approximately 9:30 PM, Patrolman Jeffrey Vaughn, assisted by Corporal Litterio, arrested **Bruce E. Hagen**, age 64, of 85 Pine Hill Road, Richmond on charges of (1) *Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/ or Drugs (BAC Unknown - 1st Offense)*, (2) *Refusal to Submit to a Chemical Test*, and (3) *Operating on a Suspended License*, after a motor vehicle stop on Church Street in Alton. Police were alerted to an erratic operator (Mr. Hagen) by another motorist who called 911 to report it. Mr. Hagen was transported to the station where he was processed and subsequently released with a summons to appear for arraignment in 4th District Court on the above criminal charges.
3. **Misdemeanors - Two arrested for Domestic-Disorderly Conduct at Chariho High School:** On March 27th, 2013 at approximately 8:30 AM, School Resource Officer Anthony Zoglio, assisted by Patrolman James Patton of the Charlestown Police Department, arrested **Caitlyn N. Marr**, age 18, and **Charles C. Barclay**, age 20, both of 27 Nooseneck Hill Road, Richmond, each on one count of *Domestic - Disorderly Conduct*, after school administrators intervened to stop altercation in the parking lot where the two were reportedly yelling at each other and hitting one another. Officers learned that an argument occurred as Mr. Barclay was dropping Ms. Marr off at Chariho where she is a student. Ms. Marr and Mr. Barclay were transported to the station where they were processed before being transported to 4th District Court for arraignment on the above charges.

4. **Misdemeanor - Motor Vehicle:** On March 27, 2013 at approximately 3:30 PM, Corporal William Litterio arrested **Richard M. Hewins**, age 41, of 172 Ferner Hill Road, Hope Valley, on a charge of *Operating with a Suspended License*, after a motor vehicle stop on Kingstown Road revealed that his license had been suspended in January 2012 for *No Proof of Insurance*. Mr. Hewins was transported to the station where he was processed, and released with a summons to appear for arraignment in 4th District Court on the above charge.
5. **Wayward Juvenile - Possession Alcohol by Minor:** On March 30, 2013 at 9:45 PM, Patrolmen Jeffrey Vaughn and John Randall were dispatched to the intersection of Punch Bowl Trail and Small Pox Trail in reference to two (2) vehicles that were seen traveling off of the roadway onto private property via a dirt road. Officers walked into the wooded area and located the vehicles and four (4) occupants. During their interaction, officers arrested a **14-year-old juvenile male** on a charge of *Possession of an Alcoholic Beverage by an Underage Person* after they found him in possession of an open can of beer. The juvenile was transported to the station, where he was processed and released to his mother. The youth shall be petitioned into Family Court on the above charge.
6. **Misdemeanor - Motor Vehicle:** On March 31, 2013 at approximately 2:00 AM, Patrolman Daniel Kelley arrested **Michael J. Grimmer**, age 28, of 18 Barbara Street, Providence, on a charge of *Operating with a Suspended License*, after a motor vehicle stop on Kenyon Hill Trail revealed that his license had been suspended in January 2013 for *Failure to Appear/Pay*. Mr. Grimmer was transported to the station where he was processed, and was released with a summons to appear for arraignment in 4th District Court on the above charge.
7. **Wayward Juvenile - Disobedient/Runaway:** On March 31, 2013, at approximately 4:00 PM, Patrolmen Adam Andrukiewicz charged a **15-year-old juvenile female** with being *Wayward - Disobedient/Runaway*, as she had left her parents Richmond home at about 1:00 PM the previous day, and refused to return. The youth had exchanged a few text messages with her parents refusing to disclose her location and refusing to return home then stopped communicating later Saturday night. The following day, she arranged to meet with her parents but refused to disclose who she had been with or where she had been. The parents sought the assistance of the police to have her referred to Family Court. The youth shall be petitioned into Family Court on the above charge.
