PRESS RELEASE – January 22, 2013:

1. Misdemeanor- Motor Vehicle: On January 16, at 1:49 AM, Corporal William Litterio arrested **Brandon T. Ring**, age 22 of 138 Woodville Alton Road, Hopkinton on a charge of **Operating on a Suspended License**. Mr. Ring had been stopped on Switch Road for a registration violation. It was later learned that his license had been suspended. Mr. Ring was processed at the station and released with a summons to appear for arraignment on February 07, 2013 for the above criminal charge.
2. Wayward-Juvenile-Possession of Marijuana: On January 16, at 11:04 AM, School Resource Officer Anthony Zoglio arrested a 17-year-old female at the Chariho High School on a charge of **Possession of Marijuana** after a teacher smelled an odor of marijuana in the girls bathroom and then on the student. The student was later found to be in possession of a small quantity of the substance. The juvenile will be referred to Family Court on the above charge.
3. Misdemeanor - Motor Vehicle: On January 16, at 9:16 PM, Patrolman Justin Vachon arrested **Richard Bell, Jr.**, age 26, of 1 Highview Avenue Hope Valley on a charge of **Operating on a Suspended License**. Mr. Bell had been stopped for a motor vehicle equipment violation which was observed on Nooseneck Hill Road. Mr. Bell was processed at the station and released with a summons to appear for arraignment on February 21, 2013, in 4th District Court on the above criminal charge.
4. Wayward Juvenile – Disorderly Conduct: On January 17, at 11:00 AM, Patrolman Jeffrey Vaughn arrested a 14-year old male student at Chariho for **Disorderly Conduct**. He was charged after becoming verbally abusive to staff and disruptive to the learning environment before walking off from school. The juvenile will be referred to Family Court on the above charge.

5. Misdemeanor-Motor vehicle: On January 20, at 8:48 PM Patrolman Andy Briody arrested James S. Dorsey, age 20, of 116 Boombridge Road, N. Stonington CT on a charge of **Reckless Driving**. Mr. Dorsey was observed driving his vehicle through the intersection of Spring Green Drive onto Main Street at a high rate of speed without stopping or having his headlights on. The vehicle continued at a high rate of Speed East on Main Street before being stopped. Mr. Dorsey was transported to the police station where he was processed and given a summons to appear in 4th District Court on February 14, to answer to the charge.
