PRESS RELEASE – March 19, 2013:

1. **Misdemeanor – Reckless Driving:** On March 13, 2013 at approximately 9:45 AM, Patrolman Adam Andrukiewicz arrested **Vernon S. Lawrence**, age 36, of 44 Nelson Drive, Exeter on a charge of **Reckless Driving** after Mr. Lawrence was observed passing vehicles (in a no passing zone) at high rates of speed with insufficient clearance to overtake other vehicles. Mr. Lawrence was processed at the station and was subsequently released with a summons to appear in 4th District Court for arraignment on the above charge.
2. **Misdemeanor - Motor Vehicle:** On March 15, 2013 at approximately 6:00 PM, Patrolman Steven Gravier arrested **John B. Brown**, age 20, of 215 Ferner Hill Road, Hope Valley, on a charge of *Operating with a Suspended License*, after a motor vehicle stop on Main Street revealed that his license had been suspended for *Failure to Appear/Pay Fines*. Mr. Brown was processed at the station, and was released with a summons to appear for arraignment in 4th District Court on the above charge.
3. **Misdemeanor – DUI (BAC Unknown) & Refusal:** On March 16, 2013, at approximately 2:00 AM, Patrolman Daniel Kelley, assisted by Corporal Justin Vachon, arrested **Jose I. Segura**, age 40, of 384 Gardiner Road, West Kingston on charges of (1) *Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/ or Drugs (1st Offense)* and *Refusal to Submit to a Chemical Test*, after officers responded to a motor vehicle accident at 90 Old Mountain Trail, where Mr. Segura's vehicle collided with a utility pole and overturned. Mr. Segura was processed at the station, and was subsequently released with a summons to appear for arraignment in 4th District Court on the above DUI charge.

4. Misdemeanor- Domestic Disorderly Conduct & Domestic Malicious Damage:
On March 16, 2013 at approximately 10:30 PM, Corporal William Litterio and Sergeant Michael Lawing arrested **Michael T. Appt**, age 21, of 63 Hoxsie Road, Richmond on charges of (1) *Domestic - Disorderly Conduct* and (2) *Domestic - Malicious Damage*. The arrest stemmed from a 911-call reporting a disturbance at the above address. Officers arrived and learned that Mr. Appt had kicked and damaged several interior doors of the home, and smashed framed pictures. Mr. Appt was returned to the station where he was processed before being arraigned on the above charges by Justice-of-the-Peace (JP) Michael Robinson. JP Robinson issued a *No-Contact Order* to Mr. Appt barring him from contacting the involved victims, and released him on \$1,000 personal recognizance.

5. Misdemeanor - Motor Vehicle: On March 18, 2013 at approximately 10:00AM, Patrolman Steven Gravier arrested **Jason M. Thornton**, age 39, of 8 High View Avenue, Hope Valley, on a charge of *Operating with a Suspended License*, after a motor vehicle stop on Main Street revealed that his license had been suspended for *Failure to Appear/Pay Fines*. Mr. Thornton was processed at the station and was subsequently released with a summons to appear for arraignment in 4th District Court on the above charge.
